

**Valley Christian School
Admission Policy**

1. Valley Christian School (VCS) admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at Valley Christian School. The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin, or gender as created by God, in the admissions process or in the implementation of its programs or activities.
2. Each family must read and formally acknowledge the VCS Mission, Vision, Core Values and Statement of Faith (see the document contained in this packet or online at <http://www.vcskids.com/about>). To be comfortable in the VCS environment, the applicant's family lifestyle should reflect the Christian principles reflected in these documents.
3. VCS is a Christian school that stands on Biblical principles and we believe that the school is an extension of the home and its values. What we believe directly impacts the teaching and nurturing of the children in our care. Since the stated purpose of VCS is to partner with each parent to equip children for life, it is important that the values of the applicant and the parent be in harmony with the Christian principles taught at VCS. On those occasions in which the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home is counter to or in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the school teaches, the school reserves the right to refuse admission of an applicant or to discontinue the enrollment of a student.
4. The goal of VCS is to provide a safe and secure environment for all students. To ensure this safety, VCS does not accept students where any adult related to the student and who actively participates in their guardianship, is listed on any state's sex offender registry.
5. All applicants will be interviewed by VCS administration to determine if VCS can meet the physical, social and academic needs of the child prior to enrollment.
6. A student who is disruptive to the educational process interferes with the progress of other students. Therefore, students transferring from other institutions must have an above average deportment record.
7. Each parent must sign the Parents Pledge of Support upon enrollment.
8. VCS administration will make the final determination in matters of student admission.
